FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What programmes does SASTRA offer through online mode?

Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Computer Applications, Master of Business Administration, Master of Computer Applications, M.Sc(Data Science), M.A (Sanskrit), M.A (Divya Prabandham)

2. What is the eligibility?

UG courses: A pass in +2 examination recognized by any State Board/ Central Board or any other Board accepted by SASTRA as equivalent to 10+2 examination.

Master of Business Administration (MBA): Any recognized bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration.

Master of Computer Applications (MCA)/M.Sc.(Data Science): Any recognized bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration with Mathematics as subject of study in +2 or qualifying degree course.

M.A. (Sanskrit): Any recognized bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration with Sanskrit as subject of study in +2 or qualifying degree course or a pass in Kovidha examination.

M.A. (Divya Prabhandam): Any recognized bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration with Tamil as subject of study in +2 or qualifying degree course.

M.Com: Any recognized bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration in commerce.

M.Sc. (Business Analytics): Any recognized bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration.

3. Application and Admission Process

6. How often the admission process for online programmes is going to happen annually?

Two times annually, January session and July session.

7. What is the structure of the course?

Undergraduate course: 6 Semesters with total credits of 120
Postgraduate course: 4 Semesters with total credits of 80
Every course consists of four quadrants. Quadrant 1- Video lectures, Q2- Self learning materials, Q3- Webinars and Q4- Assessments.

8. What is the maximum duration to complete the Programme?

Twice the duration of the programme. For example, the duration of MCA programme is two years and the courses must be completed

successfully within four years from the date of registration of the programme.

9. How is the course/study material made available for the candidate?

The courses will be uploaded in LMS platform. The required credentials will be shared to the admitted students. In the LMS platform, you will have access to all the four quadrants. Admitted students will have access to Video lectures, self learning materials, webinars and Assessments.

10. Is the presence of the candidate required in the campus?

The Programme is online and the presence of the candidate is not required in the campus.

11. How and when are the Webinars conducted?

The webinars are conducted through online during week days and weekends. The schedule will be intimated in advance to the admitted students.
